



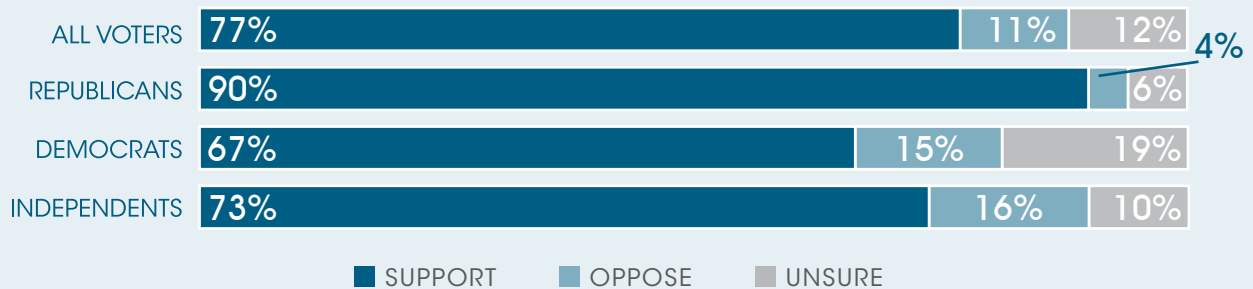
# PENNSYLVANIA VOTERS SUPPORT Program Integrity



## FOOD STAMP PROGRAM INTEGRITY

The state would be required to cross-check state data-sets to verify eligibility for benefits. This data includes lottery winnings, death records, employment records, out-of-state EBT transactions, and incarceration records.

**Voters support checking food stamp eligibility more frequently and with better technology to ensure those receiving benefits are actually eligible.**



### REPORTING REQUIREMENT

Food stamp recipients should **report changes in their financial circumstances** that could make them ineligible for the program within 10 days.



### CHILD SUPPORT COOPERATION REQUIREMENT

Individuals receiving taxpayer-funded food stamps should **cooperate with the state's attempt to collect child support** as a condition of receiving benefits.



### CHECKING FINANCIAL ASSETS

Food stamp applicants' **financial assets, such as expensive homes and cars, should be checked** to make sure they are not fraudulently applying for benefits.





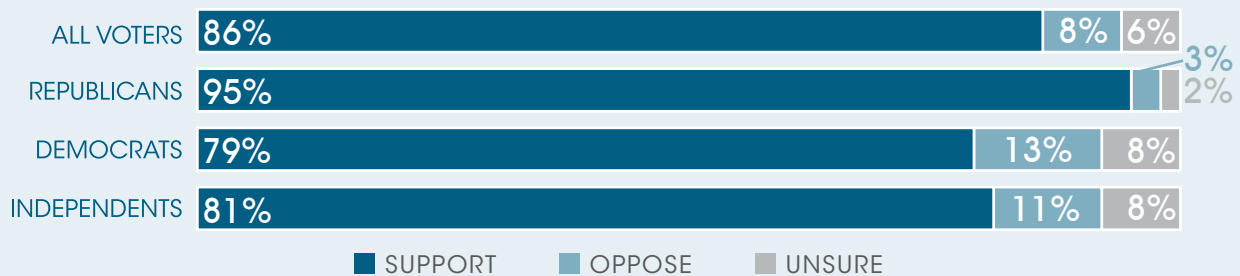

## MEDICAID PROGRAM INTEGRITY

The state would be required to cross-check state data-sets to verify eligibility, including wages, employment, residency, and death records. The department must also independently verify all state exchange applicants.

**Voters support verifying Medicaid applicants' eligibility to make sure they are actually eligible to receive benefits.**



### MEDICAID WAIVERS: REDETERMINATIONS

Medicaid enrollees' **eligibility would be verified more often and with better technology** to make sure they are still eligible.



### MEDICAID WAIVERS: PRESUMPTIVE ELIGIBILITY

Hospitals would be required to **verify Medicaid eligibility for patients** before taxpayers are asked to pay the bill.



### MEDICAID WAIVERS: LOCK OUT

Medicaid **benefits would be restricted for six months** as a consequence for refusing to report income changes.



### MEDICAID WAIVERS: RENEWALS

Medicaid **benefits would not be automatically renewed** so continued eligibility can be verified.

## UNEMPLOYMENT PROGRAM INTEGRITY

The state would be required to cross-check state datasets to verify eligibility, including new-hire records and incarceration records.

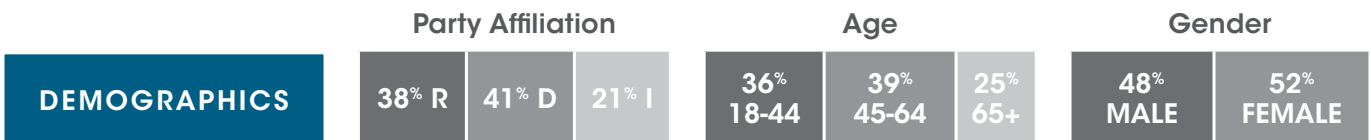
**Voters support requiring unemployment applications to be checked against existing data to stop incarcerated individuals from collecting unemployment.**



**Voters support checking new hire records weekly in order to make sure that individuals receiving unemployment benefits are actually unemployed.**

Results for this poll are based on automated telephone interviews conducted among a nationwide sample of 514 likely voters in Pennsylvania. Data for this survey research was collected by Cor Strategies Inc.

Interviews were conducted via a computer-assisted telephone interviewing system utilizing techniques designed to achieve the highest possible respondent cooperation.

The surveys were conducted November 9-11, 2020. The margin of sampling error is plus or minus 4.32 percentage points. The margin of sampling error may be higher for certain subgroups. Results presented may not always appear to total 100 percent due to rounding.

Data was sampled using weighted demographic information from the U.S. Census Bureau's Current Population Survey Voting and Registration Supplement and the state election authorities. Demographic information for actual voters in past elections were used to construct sample target weights.

The Foundation for Government Accountability paid for all costs associated with this survey.

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
