



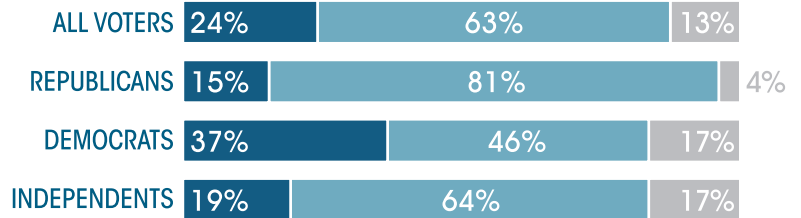

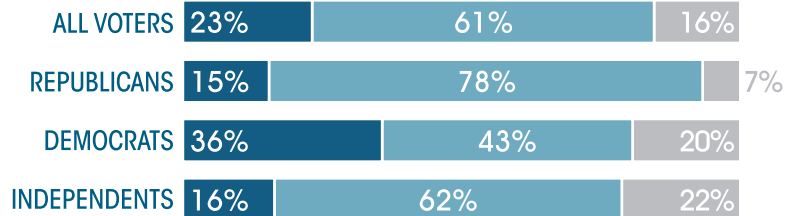
### WORK REFUSALS

### JOB LOSSES

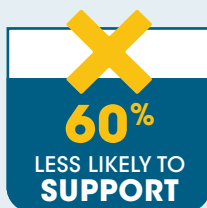
Voters do not want jobs being sent overseas or automated.

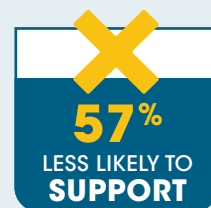
The package encourages workers to refuse suitable work offers, which is unemployment insurance fraud.

The stimulus package could slow down the economic recovery.





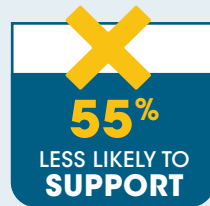

## KEY MESSAGES

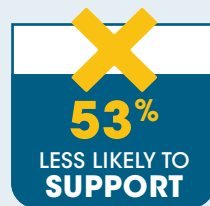
A **\$15 minimum wage** would make it more **difficult** for young and less educated workers to get their first job.



Much of the aid to states and municipalities would go **directly to public sector unions** instead of benefiting state taxpayers.



The extra funding to states would **disincentivize them** from reopening their economies.



**Unemployment is already decreasing sharply**, even without this expensive legislation.

Results for this poll are based on automated telephone interviews conducted among a nationwide sample of 512 likely voters. Data for this survey research was collected by Cor Services, Inc.

Interviews were conducted via a computer-assisted telephone interviewing system utilizing techniques designed to achieve the highest possible respondent cooperation.

The surveys were conducted February 16-17, 2021. The margin of sampling error is plus or minus 4.33 percentage points. The margin of sampling error may be higher for certain subgroups. Results presented may not always appear to total 100 percent due to rounding.

Data was sampled using weighted demographic information from the U.S. Census Bureau's Current Population Survey Voting and Registration Supplement and the state election authorities. Demographic information for actual voters in past elections were used to construct sample target weights.
